You will learn about how the School Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships in NSW program offers support to help you take on and train a senior school student to suit your business.

Your apprentice or trainee will undertake a combination of industry specialised training and one day per week in your paid employment, whilst undertaking the HSC.

School based apprentices complete the first stage of a trade qualification by the end of their HSC year.

Trainees complete an initial qualification by the end of Year 12.

The benefits

- A part-time apprentice or trainee will contribute to your business growth and develop the skills base of tomorrow.
- Training costs are currently 'Fee-free' under a NSW Government initiative and financial incentives make school based apprenticeships and traineeships a viable employment option. You can expect a tailor-made worker trained and available full-time after their HSC.
- Flexible training arrangements mean you can negotiate the training program with your nominated registered training organisation.
- Your trainee or apprentice will be trained in a nationally recognised qualification.

Employer's responsibilities

- Paid employment of a minimum 100 days* over HSC **Some trades require more paid days.*
- Provide a safe working environment, with appropriate supervision.
- Provide an induction and orientation program.
- Provide the opportunity for the student to acquire the skills and knowledge in their vocation or trade.
