



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The South Coast Centre of Excellence has partnered with TAFE NSW to offer a scholarship open to hospitality workers currently working in the industry to complete a SIT30622 Certificate III in Hospitality qualification.

What is included

The scholarship program includes opportunities for scholarship recipients to access the following Centre of Excellence programs to support their studies:

- Mentorship through the Centre of Excellence Mentor Program where you are matched to an industry mentor who will guide you through your education and skills development
- Invitations to attend industry famils to experience the tourism and hospitality offerings in your own backyard
- Enrolment to attend the “Introduction to Australian Wine” course delivered by the Sydney Wine Academy
- Invitation to attend relevant professional development courses

Who is eligible

Applicants will ideally be already working in hospitality and may have completed some units of competency that could be recognised as prior learning.

This is a flexible delivery course with knowledge assessments conducted online with practical assessments being evaluated at local TAFE colleges located at Nowra, Moruya and Bega.
