



Barriers to training

- ► Lack of time
- ▶ Cost
- ► Location / distance to travel
- ► Access to appropriate courses

Key Findings

- ► The greatest challenge to business was lack of labour and skilled staff
- ▶ In excess of 6,950 job vacancies
- Back of house is the majority of the requirements
- ► Time, cost, distance and access to courses were the barriers to providing training
- Traineeships and internships viewed favourably by industry

Three target groups

1. Schools, unemployed and under employed

Attract and create a pipeline of new recruits to the industry

2. Current Workforce

Retain and develop the skills of current workers

3. Owner/Operators

Support business to grow
